

Crayon Box



You Will Need:

- A pack of 24 crayons
- Glue Stick
- Paper

- Cardstock (or empty cereal box)
- Scissors or Craft Knife
- Ruler

Directions:

- 1. Print pages 1-2 on regular printer paper
- 2. Print page 3 on heavy cardstock or print on regular paper and adhere to light cardboard, like a cereal box.
- 3. Cut out all the crayon labels
- 4. Cut out the crayon box
- 5. Remove the labels from your new crayons. Use a craft knife to cut a shallow slit down the side of the label for easy removal.
- 6. Match the name written next to the label of the crayon with the one on the original crayon. Apply a generous layer of glue stick to the back of a label and roll it onto the crayon, making sure the side with the crayon color name overlaps the other end.
- 7. Repeat for the rest of the crayons
- 8. Score the fold lines on the crayon box and assemble, gluing the white tab only.
- 9. Place your crayons inside the box
