# Perfect Scratch Art

Follow these steps to help your child create their own scratch art masterpiece!

#### Materials:

- Sturdy white art paper or cardstock
- Oil pastels or crayons
- Black tempera paint
- Small paintbrush or foam brush
- Toothpick, plastic fork, chopstick, or other tool that works as a stylus

#### **Instructions:**

**Step 1:** Protect your surface by covering your work area with newspaper.

**Step 2:** Using oil pastels or crayons, let your child color in the entire sheet of paper in as many colors as possible—the more colors the better.

**Step 3:** With a paintbrush or foam brush, help your child to completely paint over the colored-in paper until the entire sheet is black. (This may require two coats.)


**Step 4:** After the paint has dried thoroughly, have your child use a toothpick or other stylus to scratch shapes or words to reveal their colorful scratch art!
